## Main resources in Sciences



**Techniques de l'ingénieur** is a document database offering summary articles in various fields of science, particularly engineering. You will also find laws, regulations, patents and standards, as well as a dictionary offering multilingual definitions and diagrams (4 languages).



**WEB OF SCIENCE** reports on global scientific literature. You will find articles from journals, conference proceedings and a wide range of content: physics, chemistry, biology, engineering, medicine, etc.



**SCIFINDER-N-** (before consulting, you have to create an account) Scifinder-n is the search interface for Chemical Abstracts, the reference database for chemistry.
